Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share a story with your child can they talk about what you have read? Enjoy playing a game/role play with the characters from the story 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask your child how they are feeling. Can they identify different emotions? E.g. happy, sad, angry, frustrated, joyful or cheeky. Encourage your child to find a quiet space to calm if they are feeling cross or angry. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can your child use one handed tools such as scissors, paintbrushes, pencils, chalks, knife and fork, chopsticks? Speak to your child about how to use one handed tools safely 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore different prints with your child E.g. books, magazines, online texts Look for letters/words in the environment around you Can you read some simple words in a paper, magazine, book? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss the fiveness of five e.g. recognise five, identify five items, knowing five is one more than four. Can they write the number five? Can they find five objects? Watch Number blocks episode number 5. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk to your child about the special places in the community. Talk about why these places are special to others/yourself 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you build a tower/building with some construction blocks? Can your child create a city with these blocks? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show your child the sounds: v,y,w,z,sh Can they say the correct and pure sound? 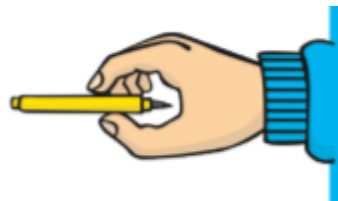
