ARRIVAL TIMES

Nursery children will arrive and leave from the usual entrances and at the normal times.

Reception (Pear, Apple and Damson)

Arrive between **8:45am and 9:00am** from the Main Gate and walk around the back of the Reception Garden to the right. Children will be greeted by their teacher and dropped off at the door. Children will be collected at **3pm** from their classroom.

Year 1 (Holly and Maple)

Arrive between **8:45am and 9:00am** from the Breakfast Club Entrance and will drop off children at the door. Children will be collected at **3pm** from the Breakfast Club entrance.

Year 1/2 (Elm, Willow and Rowan)

Arrive between **8:40am and 8:55am** from the Stan Peterson Close gate. Parents/carer will drop off children at the Muga and will be greeted by a Teacher and children will go to their classroom to be registered by their TA (or vice versa). Children will be collected at **3pm** from the Muga.

We would like to remind parents that all children should arrive to school by 9.00am
Lateness causes disruption to classes and children to miss their learning time.

FACE COVERINGS

ABSENCES

If your child is going to be absent from school, please leave a message on the Pupil Absence line (01603 433957 - Option 1) no later than 8.30am. Please give your child's name, class and reason for absence.

For any planned absences other than for medical reasons, a Leave of Absence form must be completed and returned to the school. A form can be requested from the school office. Please note holidays and other planned absences will not be authorised, only in exceptional circumstances.
