





You can begin by tracing your name and then independently form some letters correctly.</li> <li>Do you remember the rhyme formation?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>See if you can pour a jug of water into a tall container. Can you count how long it took to fill the container?</li> <li>Listen to a chicken making a continuous sound: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=h8Q-jlHBcXM">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=h8Q-jlHBcXM</a> Focus on 0:39-0:49 of the clip. Can you count how long the chicken makes a sound for?</li> <li>See if you can count the stairs you climb, the mouthfuls you eat or the hops you can do.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Listen to this clip about the changing seasons: <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/evfs-playtime-seasons/zvgj47h">https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/evfs-playtime-seasons/zvgj47h</a></li> <li>Encourage your child to talk about the cress plants we have grown in Nursery. What are the changes you have noticed?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When drawing or painting, discuss with your child the colours they have chosen to represent emotions e.g. red for angry, blue for calm, yellow for happiness.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recap the sounds we have learnt which are, 'm', 'a', 's', 'd', 't', 'i', 'n', 'p', 'g', 'o'.</li> <li>Can you remember the rhyme formation for some of the sounds?</li> <li>Don't forget to say the pure sounds.
