### FREE SCHOOL MEALS ELIGIBILITY

Next week we will be texting food voucher codes to parents of children who are entitled to means tested income and benefit related free school meals. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive universal infant free school meals. However you can apply for the school to get extra funding from the Government (Pupil Premium) if you are on a low income or are in receipt of benefits.
